In 1974, Greg O'Flynn opened his own unique wine shop that was well ahead of its time. After tasting wines from all over the world, Greg determined that wines from California were outstanding. Even wine judges in France ranked two California wines higher than some of the best French wines in a famous 1976 Paris tasting. The mid '70's was a very exciting time in the California wine industry. Wines from the likes of Caymus, Stag's Leap, Diamond Creek, Chateau Montelena, Dehlinger, Joseph Swan, Duckhorn, Joseph Phelps, and many other notable wineries were brand new at that time, and it was these, and more, that made up the selection at our shop. Pioneering new wines is one of the aspects of being a wine merchant that we enjoy the most. We love finding that next great wine before anyone else knows about it. The original location of the CWM was just over on Pierce Street in the same Marina District we are in now. The unique floor to ceiling redwood wine racks that are still with us were personally hand built by Greg himself. Our retail wine shop operated continuously at that original location for 30 years. In 2004, Greg and Deborah moved the business literally just around the corner onto Chestnut Street into what was formerly an outdated neighborhood bar and turned it into a destination. The 20 ft long parquet oak bar was re-finished, and Greg and Deborah remodeled and renovated the new location keeping the same look and feel of the original shop. Our thriving Wine Bar was born, in addition to our retail wine operation, and our robust Quarterly Wine Club followed.
